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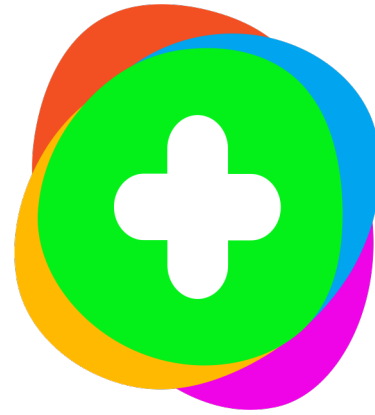
# WHAT IS A FLIPHUNT?

Flipgrid is a video discussion platform that helps educators see and hear from every student in class and foster a fun and supportive social learning environment.

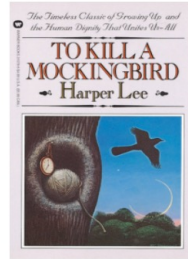

- Use your body to show one example of a hinge joint. Move yours and explain how it works.
